Minutes from last committee meeting were approved. Reviewed possibility of minutes to go on website which is currently being modified.

Secretary reviewed thoughts on what should be included in church bulletin announcements.

Cub Master thanked all those who participated/helped with Cub Adventure World. Activity consent forms and pack picnic forms were handed out. Ribbons for 2008 Quality Awards Program and Cub Adventure World were displayed. Den membership cards were distributed to den leaders. Den leaders were asked to update the Pack Master to assure it is up to date. A review of when scouts can cross over was discussed.

Outings: The cave overnight is March 27. Maximum amount of participants is 120. The scouts will have an exclusive night starting at 6:30 with 6 tour guides and evening snack. Morning will include breakfast and Onnmax. An estimated 45 people are already prepared to participate. A motion was made to pay now to secure the overnight date which was passed. Funding ideas to keep the cost down for scouts was discussed. Suggested to have cave overnight sign up by November and pay by January. Eldora will be \$20.00 per kid without a uniform and the event will run from 2:00 to 11:00.

Pack T-shirts were discussed. A motion was made and passed to buy shirts in bulk. Shirt will have a standardized design. Shirts will be \$10.00.

Budget is at \$4,824.11. The last car wash raised \$328.

Religious awards: Scout Sunday will be February 2 at 11:00 mass. A discussion of the numerous religious awards and funding ensued. It was decided the pack will pay for the first award in such instances with the family paying for any ensuing awards/patches of the same series.

Public relations; a newsletter will be ready by Tuesday.

Achievement awards, reviewed need to have a list of awards the Wednesday before Pack meeting. Cards are needed for each belt loop award.

Membership/Registration; links for training for scout leaders will be sent out.

Popcorn; Kickoff is August 24. One point of contact is desired for each den. There will be an account for each scout. Reviewed idea of show and sells; a popcorn committee was formed and will report at next meeting. Will review selling some popcorn at quarter auctions.

Round Table: reviewed 100 years of scouting coming this year with many events suggested.

A pancake breakfast will be looked into.

The by-laws were reviewed by ad hoc committee and suggestions were made.
