Minutes from the last meeting were approved. It was noted that any scout interest stories could be brought to Mrs. Poling's attention to send into the Catholic Telegraph.

A list of upcoming dates was reviewed, including Cub Fall Explosion and the Sunwatch for new scouts activity day, both in October.

The financial report included plans to review finances with each activity chairperson and statements for each den. Balance of \$5,329.79 reported. A discussion on having the treasurer report listed on the web site as a web link ensued with a decision not to have this as a listing.

On the last Wed. of each month there is training for scout leaders. A flyer with more details was handed out.

The webmaster reported that the Cub site has been redone. The webmaster can be emailed with any questions or ideas. Den leaders can be listed on the web; the need for consent forms for being listed was discussed. A slide show photo album is on the web, more photos would be welcome.

Public relations noted there is a template for the new newsletter.

Popcorn kernel proposed that the first \$40.00 proceeds for each scout from selling pay for scout activities and each dollar after that be placed in each scout's account for scout activities; proposal was passed. Buyout at \$40.00 was an option.

T-shirt designs were voted on and approved.

A report on the Pinewood Derby was given with the next event Oct. 25. There will also be an event on November 8th tied into a fundraiser which will have details on the website. Web racing had raised an additional \$210; when added to the \$190 already raised there has been \$400 raised, creating additional payments for the trailer. A discussion on when to present the pinewood derby kits was reviewed as they may need to be given out earlier than usual due to the earlier races in the upcoming year.

Boy's Life was mistakenly not renewed. Den leaders will be asked to check addresses with their den and see if the magazines are wanted.

The idea of a Poinsettia fundraiser was discussed and approved.

The pack meeting on September 18th was discussed, with each den to present a skit and the new Tigers will be introduced. The pack meeting on October 19th will include the crossover for 6 Webelo II's.
