

WEBOLOS WOODS 2012

WHAT IS IT?

Webolos Woods is a Boy Scout driven camping event where Webolos I and II scouts can meet various Boy Scout troops from the Texas Skies District and participate in various BSA events. Webolos II who have met the requirements for the Arrow of Light may receive them during the event at a special ceremony.

WHEN AND WHERE IS IT?

January 20 – 22, 2012 @ camp Brosig. www.shac.org/camping_and_events/camps/camp_brosig

WHEN AND HOW DO I CHECK-IN AND OUT?

Check-in is between 6:30 PM and 9:30 PM on Friday or 8:00 AM – 10:00 AM on Saturday. Check-out is at 9:00 AM on Sunday pending approval of the campsite inspection. No cars will be allowed at the campsites after 9:30 PM on Friday. When you arrive at the camp, drive to the registration tent where you will be checked in and receive wristbands for all those camping. Proceed to the campsite, drop off your equipment and then drive the car back to the parking area. Camp Brosig has very limited parking at the campsites.

WHO CAN ATTEND?

Since this is a BSA driven event, only Webolos I and II scouts and their parents/guardians may attend. Siblings or other family members are not allowed to stay and camp overnight but may come to visit on the 21st to see the Arrow of Light Ceremony.

WHAT DOES IT COST?

\$15.00 for Webolos scout camping overnight

\$10.00 for each parent/guardian camping overnight

\$12.00 for the Arrow of Light award

HOW DO I REGISTER?

Jose Blanco, the Webolos II Den Leader will be handling the registrations for all those attending. The online registration starts process starts on November 1st, 2011. All those wishing to attend must have their information to Mr. Blanco no later than December 12th, 2011. All payments must be received by Mr. Blanco no later than January 10, 2012. Payments can be made by check written out to B.S.A. or cash.

WHAT INFORMATION IS NEEDED:

A COPY of the BSA Health Form and the registration form below for each person attending.

WILL FOOD BE PROVIDED?

All meals are your responsibility. Expect a burn-ban to still be in place so no liquid propane or other liquid type igniters are allowed.

CAMPSITE COMPETITION:

An award is handed out for campsites meeting certain guidelines. Mr. Blanco will have those guidelines soon so that the Webolos I and II dens can compete together. Some of the requirements are:

- Display pack and den flags
- One area for cooking all meals
- One area for cleaning cooking equipment
- One area for garbage collection
- Etc.
